- Arriving by plane: Helsinki-Vantaa (HEL) airport near the capital city is the country's biggest airport and
  offers many connections to and from other parts of the country and abroad.
- Arriving by boat: Helsinki has boat connections with Germany, Poland, Sweden, Latvia and Estonia. You can also arrive by boat via Vaasa (from Umeå, Sweden) and Turku (from Stockholm, Sweden)

- NON-EEA citizen- Requirements by country: <u>Visa requirement and travel documents accepted by Finland</u> Ministry for Foreign Affairs
